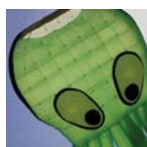

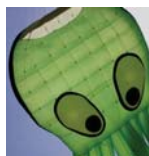

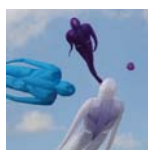
**Oly** Who's going to Brighton Kite Festival this year? 10th - 11th July 2010. Stanmer Park, Brighton, East Sussex.



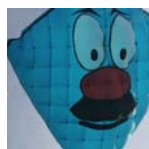
**Teddy** I should be there at Stanmer Park, Brighton, for those with Sat Nav BN1 9PZ is Stanmer House at the back of the Park



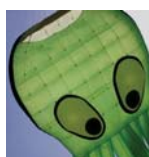
**Cody** I hear there are some great arena displays again this year from 11 am through to 5 pm and all for free.

**Oly** Hi Eddy! Don't forget to let them go to the Children's Kite workshop in the BKF information tent.



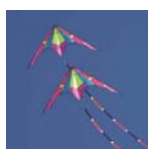
**DHL Supply Chain** We are sponsoring the kite workshop this year so please come along & join in between 1 - 3 pm.
